My advocacy for hearing loop technology has resulted in over 660 hearing loop installations in the Fox Valley and the state of Wisconsin and many more beyond. My goal is improving hearing aid compatible access in Wisconsin and beyond to the benefit of hearing and cochlear implant users.

This AC is one of only 11 (at that time) tertiary audiology centers in the country of the Netherlands. This center provided comprehensive services by a social worker, psychologist, and educational specialist and I, as the ‘logopedist’ provided hearing testing, speech and language evaluations, lip-reading and Cued Speech therapy for suddenly deafened adults.
